Contact your doctor's office if you experience any of the following:

- Fever over 102°
- Round the clock nausea/vomiting, not keeping fluids down for over 24 hours
- Excessive and/or discolored drainage from the incision
- Swelling or pain in the calf or leg
- · Hot to the touch or red incision

Call 911 if:

- · You have difficulty breathing
- · You have chest pain

Leg Bandage

If you have a bandage upon discharge from the hospital, remove it once a day to inspect your incision/leg. This is a good time to take a shower with assistance.

Infection
